
Theatre Arts Studies Declaration

Theatres Arts Studies degrees (major and minor) are open enrollment programs for any student. Students interested in general theatre studies, dramaturgy, playwriting, directing, stage management, or design and technology (costume, lighting, makeup, scenic, or sound) should declare this major or minor. There is no deadline for this declaration, but students must be declared majors before they can take most 200-level and above theatre classes.
