*Sidney Howard (1891-1939) was an eminent American playwright born in Oakland, California of pioneer parents. After graduation from the University of California at Berkeley in 1915 he studied playwriting under George Pierce Baker at Harvard. His first popular success was *They Knew What They Wanted*, which won for Howard The Pulitzer Prize for drama and established him as a leading American dramatist. He then went on to write such outstanding works as: *Lucky Sam McCarver*, *Ned McCobb's Daughter*, *The Silver Cord*, *The Late Christopher Bean*, *Yellow Jack* and *The Ghost of Yankee Doodle*. Howard won The Academy Award in 1939 for his outstanding screen play for the film *Gone With The Wind*.*
