Rare and privileged insights into Dr. Maeser's personality were given us over many years by Amy Brown Lyman who boarded with the Maesers while she attended the Y.

From all accounts Karl G. Maeser was a superb educator with a charismatic personality. Yet during his lifetime he had constantly to defend his calling against the Lot Crims (an invented name), who did not share Karl's vision of the educated Saint.

Therefore, we dedicate this work to the Lot Crims of every age, for they challenge the professional heirs of Karl G. Maeser to prove for each generation that learning may be a saintly pursuit when teachers heed Brother Brigham's famous injunction, and that the Maesers of the world may learn much from their fellow Crims.
