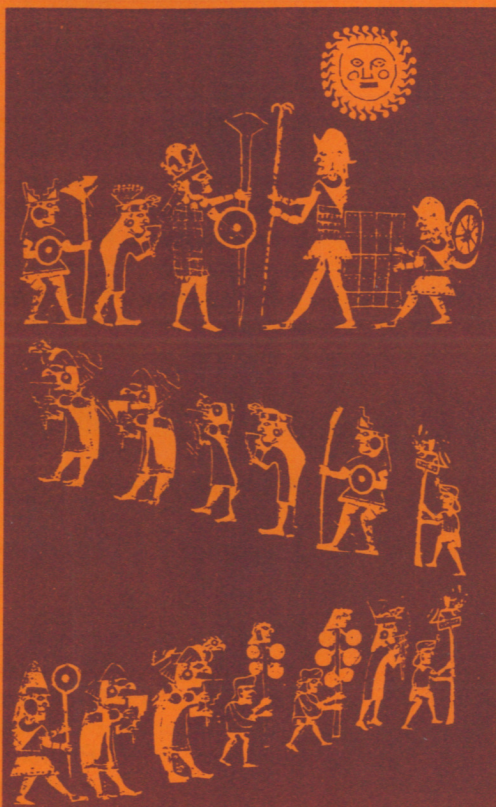


# ROYAL HUNT OF THE SUN

### Director's Notes

Place: Apart from two early scenes in Spain and Panama, the play is set in the Upper Province of the Inca Empire: what is now South Ecuador and North Western Peru. The whole of Act II takes place in the town of Cajamarca.

Time: June 1529 — August 1533

Act I: The Hunt

Act II: The Kill

There will be one five-minute intermission.

An historical drama of the Spanish Conquest of Peru, the play expands the limits of the stage to depict the clash of armies and the plunder of the Inca treasure. And at its heart is the conflict between the aging Pizarro, leader of the Conquistadores, and the young Inca ruler Atahualpa, who believes that he is descended from the Sun God and will never die.
