#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

One of the rewards I get from directing plays is the opportunity to deeply consider the motivations of unique characters and attempt to bring them to life on stage. The process is like getting to play a prolonged game of "what if" with other people's lives. Don't we all play this game every time we look back on or anticipate our upcoming choices and opportunities. The vicarious nature of a theatrical experience gives empathetic audience members the same opportunity every time they settle into their seats and the house lights fade.

Little Shop is a dark comedy. It appears light and frothy on the surface, but beneath that façade churn deep and sometimes ominous waters—the consequences of our everyday decisions. Yes, we don't always know what's at the end of the roads we choose to travel, but we can certainly assure a more positive outcome if we pay more attention to the road signs along the way. As you enjoy this cautionary tale, see if you can identify the warning signs Seymour innocently ignores. What plants are we choosing to feed each day with precious drops of our blood, sweat, and tears? Will they eventually bear the fruits of the Spirit that make us the men and women we dream of becoming? May we have eyes to see, ears to hear, and hearts that forgive and open wide to receive forgiveness.

#### Megan Sarah Smith Ensemble/ Interviewer


