



Media Arts MAJOR Graduation Plan Packet

Before creating your graduation plan, make sure you have met with your Media Arts Faculty Advisor at least once. They can give you some insights on creating this graduation plan.

Developing a graduation plan. Referring to the Media Arts MAP, the Media Arts Course Frequencies List and the Media Arts Major Flowchart (all found at film.byu.edu/application), create a graduation plan on the worksheets provided. Include all of your GE requirements, major requirements, and Media Arts electives each semester until you graduate. Remember to take note of the semester each class is offered as well as pre-requisites. (You are encouraged to discuss possible electives in your first meeting with your faculty advisor.)

- **Requirements for Media Arts Majors:**
 - o The Media Arts Studies Program requires 51 credit hours:
 - 31 Credits of required credit hours (Can be found on the Media Arts MAP)
 - A minimum of 20 MA elective credits
 - o 14 elective credits must be upper division (upper division includes classes in the 300 and 400 level.)
 - o No more than 8 credits of electives can be from practica classes. (170R, 270R, 370R, 184R, 284R, 384R)
 - o Upper-level division classes from a non-Media Arts minor could be counted as MA electives with approval from your faculty advisor.

- **After completing your graduation plan, double-check the following:**
 - o Media arts class scheduling and prerequisites (which semesters the course is offered and which prerequisites must be fulfilled for each course)
 - o Total number of electives. If you will minor in another department, include those credits as your electives
 - o General education (be aware the Languages and Learning requirement may require more than a 3 credit class to fill)
 - o Religion requirements
 - o Since GE and religion courses are offered much more frequently than Media Arts courses, you may want to schedule the specific GE/religion classes around your Media Arts courses
 - o Do NOT show double majors on your graduation plan; only reflect courses for the Media Arts Major. The University discourages double majors. Any exceptions must be approved by the University Advisement Center.

Finally, Have your graduation plan and electives sheet reviewed and approved by the CFAC Advisement Center (D444 HFAC, 801.422.3777). You must receive a signature from the Advisement office to submit your Grad Plan in your application.
