



Media Arts MINOR Graduation Plan Packet

Before creating your graduation plan, make sure you have met with your Media Arts Faculty Advisor at least once. They can give you some insights on creating this graduation plan.

Developing a graduation plan. Referring to the Media Arts MAP, the Media Arts Course Frequencies List and the Media Arts Major or Minor Flowchart, create a graduation plan on the worksheet provided. Include all of your GE requirements, major/minor requirements, and Media Arts electives each semester until you graduate. Remember to take note of the semester each class is offered as well as pre-requisites. (You are encouraged to discuss possible electives in your first meeting with your faculty advisor.)

- Requirements for **Media Arts Minor**:
 - 23 Credits of required credit hours (Can be found on Media Arts Minor MAP)
- After completing your graduation plan, double-check the following:
 - Media arts class scheduling and prerequisites (which semesters the course is offered and which prerequisites must be fulfilled for each course)
 - Total number of electives. If you will minor in another department, include those credits as your electives
 - General education (be aware the language requirement may require more than a 3 credit class to fill)
 - Religion requirements
 - Since GE and religion courses are offered much more frequently than Media Arts courses, you may want to schedule the specific GE/religion classes around your Media Arts courses
- **Have your graduation plan reviewed and approved** by the following advisors in the order noted (contact information below):
 - **Your Major's Academic Advisement office**: Review the sequencing and timing of **your major's** classes, general education, and religion courses on your graduation plan.
 - **CFAC Advisement Office** - Review sequencing and timing of the Media Arts Minor courses.
